

2020 Wisconsin Bankers Foundation Agricultural Banking Scholarship Program

Guidelines

Scholarship Awards

Two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each will be awarded to qualified applicants.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant is currently enrolled in a **Wisconsin** state-accredited college, university or state-operated vocational/technical school as a full-time student, with plans to continue studies in the spring 2021 semester.
- Applicants accepted to one of the government military academies are not eligible to apply.
- Applications from students attending privately run trade schools will not be accepted.

Selection Criteria

- Academic achievement
- Demonstration of financial literacy capabilities and resources
- Having a career goal related to agricultural banking/finance
- Extracurricular activities and community involvement
- Relevant experience in agriculture

Awarding of scholarships will be the responsibility of the WBA Agricultural Bankers Section Board of Directors, appointed for this specific purpose by the Foundation Board of Directors. Selection of scholarships shall be at the sole discretion of this committee. All applications will be considered without regard to the applicant's age, sex, race, religion, handicap, or other protected categories. All applications and judging records are confidential and are the property of the Wisconsin Bankers Foundation. Information about the award decision process will NOT be made available. **Granting of awards is dependent upon receipt of qualified applications.** Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Completed applications must be submitted no later than Monday, November 30, 2020
